<p>Talks@Willoughby presents Robyn Moloney and Father Shenouda Mansour</p>	<p>How does language shape our discovery of the world, spirit and self?</p> <p>'Language is about what connects us, not what sets us apart.' - Aunty Louise Campbell (Gumbaynggirr)</p> <p>In this Harmony Day session, Robyn Moloney and Father Shenouda Mansour explore the social bonds created in language journeying, as a means to better understand ourselves and others and to aid our search for intercultural identity.</p> <p>Using the new book 'Language and Spirit' as a starting point, the panel will focus on personal stories of life lived with community and Indigenous languages. These stories have common themes of wellbeing and the connections between language and spirit. They show how the strong maintenance of family languages enrich our social and emotional wellbeing, and enable us to connect to our cultural stories and histories. Two of the book's contributors will share their stories in the session.</p> <p>Father Shenouda Mansour is an ordained priest of the Coptic Orthodox Church. He came to Australia from Egypt at the age of six. For his PhD he investigated attitudes to identity, culture and language in a Coptic school community. He is the General Secretary of NSW Ecumenical Council, a body which strives to build good relationships, and networking with churches. He has ongoing interest in identity, culture, language, religious and spiritual formation. He is a regular radio program producer. He believes in being a social activist to build a better multicultural society.</p> <p>Robyn Moloney is a languages educator. She has taught French and Japanese in schools and educated young teachers at Macquarie University. Her writing and research have explored students and teachers' intercultural learning through language.
